
"LISTENING TO GOD'S WORLD": ECUMENICAL LENT COURSE 2008

This is a different kind of Lent course, written to help churches of any denomination listen to what people think about the Church and about God. It aims to help participants reflect on how the Christian faith is viewed by society and

consider why so few people now come to Church.

The course is part of preparation for the celebration of the 1100th anniversary of the Diocese of Exeter - a celebration all Christians in the county are urged to share in. It is hoped that the course will help our churches to take a new and creative place in the ongoing life of our county.

"Listening to God's World" has 5 sessions looking at how people still seek a spiritual life and why they see the church as unnecessary. It will consider how patterns of belief have changed and how we can reconnect with our communities through expressing our faith in fresh ways. Each session uses a video presentation and Bible study related to the theme of the week. (There are no booklets to buy!!)



Tavistock URC is starting this course on TUESDAY FEBRUARY 12th at 6:00pm in the Church and is an ideal follow up from the Church Day discussions. The course will be led by Revd Phyllis assisted by Rev Rog. EVERYONE WELCOME!!

Thousands of miles away in Africa, there is a greater need for the most basic items we take for granted. Please do not forget the blue box in the Church for OPERATION SUNSHINE. There is a container going out on February 2nd to Bishop Mpango in Tanzania and collecting for the next container starts again! Items particularly wanted on a regular basis include: Good clean clothing; sheets, blankets & towels; bandages, dressings & antiseptics; soap, toothbrushes & toothpaste; candles & matches; tools of ALL kinds - especially scissors of all sizes; pencils, crayons and paper; and plastic mugs, bowls, plates & cutlery.

Knitted jumpers and blankets are vital! One small blanket will keep 3 small children warm at night and protect against mosquitos. The 2 greatest killers of little children are pneumonia and malaria. So carry on knitting!!

Operation Sunshine's next fund raising event is a FONDUE PARTY to be held at the Parish Centre on Friday April 11th at 7:30pm. Tickets are already on sale priced £8.50p and you can bring your own wine!

Then there will be a PLANT SALE on Saturday May 3rd from 10am - 12:30pm at Whitchurch Village Hall. So if you have any plants left over from your gardening then they would be gratefully received by the organisers. These fund raising events provide the cash necessary to pay for the containers to be sent to their destination - so all financial donations are welcome!
